THE APPROPRIATION BILL, 2024

(Bill No. 1 of 2024)

(To be presented by the Minister for Finance)

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to charge the Consolidated Fund with the sum of Twenty-Six Billion, Five Hundred and Seventy-Seven Million, Four Hundred and Forty-Three Thousand, and One Emalangeni (E26,577,443,001.00) for the period commencing on the 1st April 2024 and ending on the 31st March 2025.

A BILL

Entitled

AN ACT to provide for the appropriation of certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1st April 2024 and ending on the 31st March 2025.

ENACTED by the King and the Parliament of the Kingdom of Eswatini.

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2024.
 - (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st April 2024.

Charge to the Consolidate Fund.

2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with the sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate of Twenty-Six Billion, Five Hundred and Seventy-Seven Million, Four Hundred and Forty-Three Thousand, and One Emalangeni (E26,577,443,001,00) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Eswatini during the financial year commencing from 1st April, 2024 and ending on the 31st March, 2025.

Application of sum appropriated.

3. The sum appropriated under section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the second column of the schedule of appropriation and in the respective amounts appearing in the third and fourth columns in respect of each service as follows-
