PRIMARY COLOR PALETTE

Use of the primary color palette, based on colors in the Swaziland flag, will enhance the impact of the Swaziland Ministry of Health brand. Consistent use of this color palette will make our materials more recognizable and uniform. It provides a strong visual link across a wide range of applications.



SECONDARY COLOR PALETTE

The secondary color palette, based on colors in the Swaziland Coat of Arms, should be used to provide an accent or to add a highlight. Avoid using these colors as the dominant color field. In most communications the primary colors should dominate.
