A King's Order-In-Council to validate the Immigration (Amendment) Act, No. 22 of 1972.

Short title.

1. This King's Order-in-Council may be cited as the Validation of the Immigration (Amendment) Order, 1973.

Validation of Act No. 22 of 1972.

2. Notwithstanding any other law or any decision of any court, the Immigration (Amendment) Act No. 22 of 1972 shall be as valid to all intents and purposes as if such Act had been duly approved of by this Council and assented to by the King in terms of the Legislative Procedure Order, No. 1 of 1973:

Provided that the said Act shall be construed as if any reference to the Constitution or any sections thereof had been omitted therefrom.

Validation of decision of the Special Tribunal.

3. Notwithstanding the decision of any court any decision of the Special Tribunal established under the Immigration (Amendment) Act No. 22 of 1972 shall be of full force and effect.
